Below are some of the things we are learning this half-term in English & Maths as well as the homework expectations for this term:

English	Maths
<p>Grammar, spelling and punctuation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adjectives • Complex sentences • Noun phrases • Prepositions <p>Writing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-Fiction • Poetry <p>Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Using the context of the sentence to help me to read unfamiliar words • Justify predictions and inferences with evidence from the text <p>We will also be continuing to have daily Book Talk sessions.</p>	<p>Angles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be exploring angles using mathematical vocabulary and investigation. • We will begin by making and finding angles in shapes, then learn how to name certain angles, specifically right angles, acute angles and obtuse angles. • We will compare angles to one another and then describe turns using both angles and fractions. <p>Lines and Shapes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will explore the different types of lines in addition to properties of shapes, both 2D and 3D. • We will identify perpendicular and parallel lines, followed by horizontal and vertical lines. • We will describe and draw 2D shapes • We will describe and make 3D shapes. <p>Perimeter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will explore perimeter. • We will measure the total length around a shape and calculate perimeter by adding all of the lengths together.
