

Writing and Reading

In Red class we will be mark-making using pencils, pens and chalk. The children will draw images of different celebrations and how they celebrate these.

We will be reading books about different celebrations and cultures.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children are developing an awareness of themselves and will develop the ability to separate happily from their caregivers. We will be introducing Zones of Regulation with the class this term. Children will be learning about happy and sad feelings and how they feel daily.



Gross and Fine Motor Skills

Children will be developing their fine motor skills through using tools when using the playdough, threading

activities and mixing and pouring in the home corner. Children will be developing their gross motor skills through climbing



on the climbing frame, using the bikes and scooters and balancing on the balance stepping stones.

What Are We Celebrating?



Expressive Arts and Design

Children will be creating fireworks using multiple media and tools, and will be wrapping presents and decorating them linked to different celebrations, creating cards for multiple celebrations and creating patterns using multiple resources and modelling skills.



Communication and Language

Red class will be developing some friendships and interactions with peers around them. Alongside this, small group work will take place to encourage these interactions modelled by adults.



Singing will take place daily. This will include learning a 'good morning' song, new nursery rhymes and some they may already know. Children will be encouraged to play alongside their friends.

Modelling and scaffolding will take place daily and encourage children to use their words or gestures to share their wants and needs with other.

Mathematics

We will be counting up to 5 using different objects, our fingers and learning these through songs. We will be learning the names of common shapes and making patterns with these.



Understanding the World

Children will be sharing festivals and celebrations they share with families and friends at home. Children will then learn from each other about similarities and differences between cultures and celebrations.
